# 3. BHH 2016 Changes and Transformations

- a. Providers shared experiences/accomplishments within BHH over the past year, including the following lessons learned:
  - Things beyond control which can hinder progress-waiting on clients, people coming and going, and other things changing
  - Huge culture changes
  - Importance and need for working with clients on their care and ensuring services are centered around and individual's preferences.
  - Communication between staff and all involved Departments-so important, but can be challenging at times
  - Creation of a gym/fitness room at agency
  - Go to CHC every week to meet with nurses and collaborate on shared clients-notice a huge difference in the number of clients getting routine care over the past year.

#### 4. Future IS Agendas

a. DMHAS would like to focus on referring to written documents created for guidance on issues. There are many resources that have been created to aid providers in managing their program operations and using those resources will limit confusion and assure continuity of the message.

# 5. Data Quality Efforts

- a. DMHAS BHH Missing Data Report-report with data through June was previously posted on Tumbleweed by Lauren. Another report that will include data through the current time period, will be posted soon. This report is in the process of being made available in the self-service section of the EDW.
- b. Health Assessment Updates
  - State Operated-deadline for submitting current health assessment worksheets is still October 1, 2016. By that date, providers should submit whatever data they have up until this point.
  - PNPs-the client summary report in the EDW now includes a field to indicate whether the health assessment was completed or not.
