1. DMHAS, ASO, and Provider Updates

- a. DMHAS Billing Updates
 - Updates on status of re-enrollment letters and remaining tasks. Any questions, contact Lauren at lauren.staiger@ct.gov.
 - PC Consultant Tracker-email with new FY18-19 tracker went out today. New contact person Ryan Grealis <u>Ryan.Grealis@ct.gov</u> is on the email. FY17-18 trackers are due by July 31, 2018.
 - Random Moment Time Study (RMTS)-Health Care Finance planning TCM and RMTS trainings. Date TBD.
- b. DMHAS Consumer Satisfaction Survey Update
 - Provided updates on the # of surveys submitted by each agency.
 - 1. CMHA has entered other surveys as well, per approval from Karin Haberlin. After confirming with Karin, there are 222 BHH surveys from CMHA.
 - 2. CMHC entering in Excel and giving to Karin to upload.
 - 3. Bridges entering all before June 30th.
 - Shared ideas from agencies able to collect their sample sizes-incentives for staff, earlier deadline for people to get in, using front desk staff to engage clients when they come in for services.

c. ASO Updates

- Staffing-still in process of interviewing candidates for BHH Director of Analytics and Innovation.
- Learning Collaborative Debrief and Ongoing Staff Training-discussed feedback from Learning Collaborative, onboarding of new staff, future similar training options (recorded, onsite, centrally located ones, etc).

- Sound Community partnering with United Community and Family Services (UCFS) for PC Consultant services.

2. CY2016 CMS Outcome Measures

- a. Reviewed important information about measures
 - i. These measures apply continuous enrollment criteria for both Medicaid and BHH for the year so some of the denominators may be very small
 - ii. The 2015 measures did not apply continuous enrollment criteria since BHH was only officially up and running for two months of 2015, making comparisions between 2015 and 2016 difficult
 - iii. The 2015 measures are still listed on the Navigation page until the next update to the page, but the report has been removed
 - iv. Duals are not included in these CMS measures since Medicare data was not available
 - v. Keep in mind there are specific service and claims codes required for calculating the measures so not all services provided may be accounted for
 - vi. The services received by clients may not have been provided by the BHH providerclients are assigned to a provider based on enrollment, not claims

- c. Went over each of the CY2016 measures in Tableau and encouraged providers to review these internally. DMHAS will also send out a PPT that can be reviewed by each agency
