

## BHH Services

**Comprehensive Care Management**— Integrate diabetes management into care plan goals and review health history to determine individual client needs.

**Care Coordination**— Link clients with providers to help care for diabetic needs. Assist clients with attending appointments and scheduling follow ups as needed.

**Health Promotion**— Educate the client on ways to manage diabetes and live a healthy lifestyle. Support the client with leaning more about diabetes.

**Comprehensive Transitional Care**— Create a discharge plan with hospital staff to incorporate the diabetic needs of the client. Review any new medications prescribed to verify they are

**Patient and Family Support**— Coach the client and family with ways to incorporate diabetes maintenance in daily life. Provide resources for diabetic meal planning and diabetic care.

**Referral to Community Support Services**— Support client with referrals to diabetes education groups in the community. Work with the client and PCP to determine if a specialist is needed for additional services.
