Check-in Meetings: Provider Specific

- Review report cards. Are there significant changes in enrollment, services, billing errors, health assessments? Develop a plan to address any issues that are identified. Plan should include a timeline and responsible parties.
 - Work with providers to design and implement a population health project.
 - At least one of the four check in meetings will be on site at the agency
 - Billing will continue to run error report and send to providers each month
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BHH Workgroup: All Providers

- Provide updates, changes, news pertinent to BHH
 - Three to four provider agencies will share on a topic.
 - Population health approach – what population will you target and how will you implement the population-specific project?
 - What area(s) is your agency doing really well in and what best practices can you share?
 - Do we have certain areas a number of agencies struggling in? Can peer support help?
 - Provide education/training in;
 - How to use BHH reports in the EDW,
 - Documentation,
 - Person centered treatment planning,
 - BHH codes and services.
 - Training needs assessment can be used to identify topics.
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Learning Collaborative: All Providers

- Present information on a topic. Focus on EBP for integrated care, how to use data to inform practice, health literacy etc. Training needs assessment can be used to identify topics.
 - Peer-to-peer interaction in small group work- how can use the information presented in day-to-day work?
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Tableau Support Group: All Providers

- Train staff on existing and new BHH reports in Tableau. Answer questions.
 - Beacon staff is available to train new staff at BHH providers.

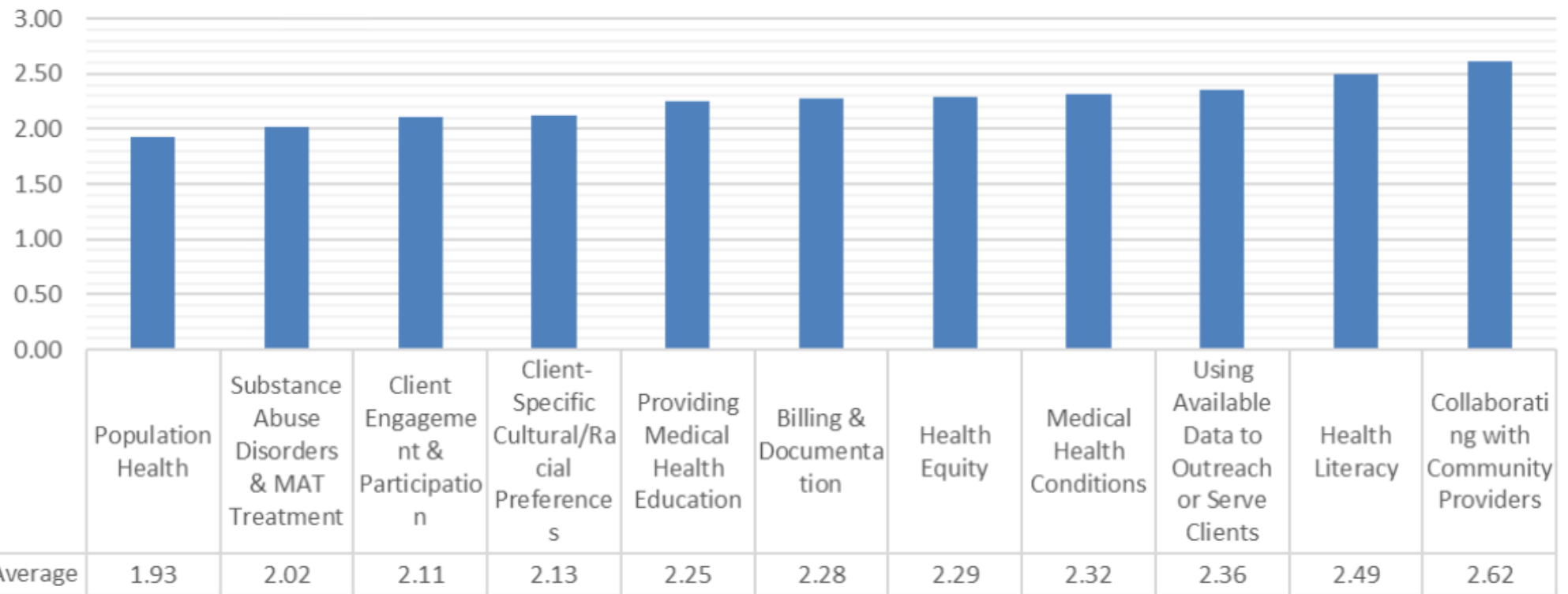
